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Day Camp **June 15 - June 25**

For boys and girls entering 2nd - 8th grades in the Fall of 2009.

Camp goes from 9:30am - 3:00pm except on June 25th, Camp will begin at 1:00pm with Family Night at 5:30pm that evening.

Drop off your camper in the church lot at 4426 Stony Creek.

Attendance — Campers do not have to attend every day to be able to come, but we encourage them to come as many times as possible. This will enable them to progress farther in their crafts. Campers may not leave camp before 3:00pm without written permission from parents turned into the caboose.

Lunch — Each camper needs to bring their own sack lunch and beverage. Please label the sack with the camper's name and grade. Do not send anything that needs refrigeration.

Free Swim — Is offered each day from 2:00pm - 3:00pm. A modest, one piece swimsuit is recommended.

Visitors — Daily Fee for Visitors is \$25.00. The visitor must be camper age and **MUST HAVE AN ADULT REGISTER THEM** at the caboose, or they will not be allowed to stay.

Family Night — This night gives the families of our campers an opportunity to see the camp in action. It is also a time for awards. Please join us from 5:30pm - 6:15pm for a free family hot dog dinner. Our program will begin at 6:30pm.
