MBC Men's Training 2025-2026

Purpose: This is an opportunity for men in the church who desire to lead in the church or grow in the area of Biblical leadership. This is also for men who seek to dig deeper into what it means to shepherd their family, the church and how the Lord has commanded them to live their life.

Overview: This year, MBC's Men's Training will begin all together, but then will offer a split track in the Spring semester. Below is an overview of this year:

Semester 1: The Masculine Mandate (Book: The Masculine Mandate)

This semester is an introduction to the call for every man to work & keep. This will touch the areas of home, work, and the church, and emphasize a man's call to leadership in these areas.

Semester 2: Split Track (Leadership/Discipleship)
